JUDGMENT

1 On October 19, 2020, this Court gave final approval to the Final Settlement between the parties
2 in the above captioned action, and issued an order to that effect (the "Final Approval Order"). The
3 Court hereby enters judgment in accordance with the Final Approval Order.

4 The Settlement Class is defined as: "All natural persons who were California citizens at the
5 time Cosio's original complaint was filed (April 5, 2016) who (a) signed a contract so that the Class
6 member, the Class member's child (or other beneficiary) could participate in a showcase operated by
7 International Performing Arts Showcase (IPAS); (b) paid IPAS for such contract; and (c) such payment
8 was made on or after April 5, 2012; (d) excluding any such payments that were (i) a percentage of the
9 income earned by the Class member's beneficiary in the entertainment industry; or (ii) consisted
10 entirely of reimbursement for out-of-pocket costs actually incurred by IP AS on behalf of the Class
11 member's beneficiary for services rendered by an independent third party."

12 The Settlement Class does not include the one individual who filed a timely and valid request
13 for exclusion: Azra Muslic.


14 As set forth in the Final Approval Order, the total amount that will be payable to all class
15 members if all class members are paid the amount to which they are entitled pursuant to the judgment
16 shall be \$393,579, plus any interest that may accrue.

17 Pursuant to the Final Settlement, Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6, and California Rules
18 of Court, Rule 3.769(h), the Court retains jurisdiction over the parties to enforce and interpret the terms
19 and conditions of the Final Settlement.

20 Notice of entry of this Judgment shall be provided to the Settlement Class Members by posting
21 it on the administrator's website for a period of not less than 60 days from the date judgment is
22 entered. It shall not be necessary to send notice of the entry of this Judgment to the Settlement Class
23 Members by any other means.

24 This document shall constitute a judgment for the purposes of California Rules of Court, Rule
25 3.769(h).)


